## **Energy Issues**

#### **Aging Housing Stock**

 Almost all our existing buildings in Nova Scotia require deep energy retrofits due to a lack of insulation, ventilation, or inefficient home heating equipment.

#### **High Energy Costs**

- Residential electricity rate of ~18 cents per kwh
- Over \$1600 to fill a residential oil tank

## **Dependence on Coal and Home Heating Oil**

- Over 200,000 homes in Nova Scotia heat with home heating oil.
- Nova Scotia has a long tradition of electricity production through coal fired generation facilities.

### **Social Issues**

#### **Poverty rate**

• 30% child poverty rate on my Island; this jumps to over 70% in nearby Indigenous communities.

#### **Historic Inequities**

- Generational trauma of Indigenous population
- 400+ year history of systemic marginalization of African Nova Scotians.

#### **Growing social consciousness**

 Growing acknowledgement of systemic issues for women, people of colour, 2SLGBTQ+, persons with disabilities, and other equity seeking groups in Atlantic Canada.
